**WHEREAS**, the General Administration Department, vide O.M No:GAD-VIGORDA/86/2023-02-GAD dated 28-11-2023, while forwarding communication No.ACB/E-163845/Veri-PR-29/2020-8414-17 dated 22-06-2023 from Anti-Corruption Bureau J&K, Srinagar, advised this Department for initiation of Regular Departmental Action against the public servants mentioned in the subject, in terms of Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956 and instructions issued vide Circular No.24-JKGAD of 2021 dated 17-07-2021;

**AND WHEREAS**, the case was examined in the Department and Memorandum, containing Articles of Charge and Statement of Imputations in support of the charges, was served on these officers for seeking their replies to the charges;

**AND WHEREAS**, the replies submitted by these officers have been examined in the Department and it has been decided to appoint an Inquiry Officer to enquire into the charges vis-à-vis replies furnished by the accused officers.

Now, therefore, in terms of sub-rule (4) of Rule 33 of the Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956, **Er. Devi Dayal**, Incharge Superintending Engineer, PW(R&B) Circle, Rajouri, is hereby appointed as Inquiry Officer to enquire into the charges framed against the officers mentioned in the subject. Besides, **Er. Javid Iqbal**, Incharge Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division, Poonch, shall be the Presenting Officer in the matter.

The Inquiry Officer shall conduct a detailed enquiry into the matter and shall submit his report/findings with specific recommendations to the Administrative Department within a period of 15 days from the date of issuance of this order.

Any modification in posting shall not debar the Inquiry Officer and the Presenting Officer in performing their duties as assigned vide this order.


