1. Review and Analysis: Conduct a comprehensive review and analysis of the NEP 2020 recommendations, aligning with its objectives.
2. Action Plan: Develop a detailed action plan for the implementation of NEP 2020, including timelines and milestones.

3. Stakeholder Engagement: Facilitate engagement with relevant stakeholders, including government agencies, educational institutions, civil society organizations, and experts in the field of education.
4. Monitoring and Evaluation: Establish mechanisms for monitoring progress and evaluating the effectiveness of the implementation efforts, ensuring alignment with the NEP indicators.
5. Capacity Building: Identify capacity-building needs and initiatives required to support the implementation of NEP 2020.
6. Policy Advocacy: Advocate for policy changes and reforms necessary to align existing education policies with the goals of NEP 2020.
7. Documentation and Reporting: Maintain records of all activities, decisions, and outcomes of the NEP Cell and prepare periodic progress reports for submission to the relevant authorities.
8. Coordination: Coordinate with other government departments and agencies involved in education-related initiatives to ensure synergy and avoid duplication of efforts, as per the coordination mechanisms outlined in NEP 2020.
