



Subject: Extension in deputation period of surplus staff of Jammu and Kashmir Cements Limited.

**Government Order No. 103 –JK(IND) of 2024
Dated: 16.07.2024**

In the interest of administration, sanction is hereby accorded to the:

1. extension in the deployment period of the employees of JKCL recommended by the Director Handicrafts and Handloom Kashmir vide letter number DHHK/Estt/C/7804 dated 12.03.2024 and DHHK/Estt/C/7989 dated 16.03.2024 and by Director Handicrafts and Handloom Jammu vide letter number DH&HJ/Estt/9/2024-02 dated 27.03.2024 for a further period of one year, from the date of expiry of earlier period of deployment, on the same terms and conditions as envisaged in respective initial deployment orders.
2. extension in the deployment period of Mr Amit Gupta presently deployed in JKTPO as recommended vide letter number JKTPO/J/Q/17/197 dated 07.03.2024 for a further period of one year, from the date of expiry of earlier period of deployment, on the same terms and conditions as envisaged in respective initial deployment orders.
3. deployment of Mr. Iqbal Singh, MTS of J&K Cements Ltd to Directorate of Industries & Commerce, Kashmir and Mr. Mohammad Maqbool Mir, Burner, J&K Cements Ltd to J&K Khadi & Village Industries Board against available vacant posts commensurate to their pay level/scale, for a period of two years or till the post is filled up on regular basis or till the official is recalled/retired, whichever is earlier, subject to the following conditions:
 - i. The salary of the official shall be drawn by the Department against the available vacant post commensurate to his pay scale/level as per the LPC issued by the J&K Advisory Board for Development of Kisans and without any deputation/deployment allowance.
 - ii. COLA/DA shall be paid at the rates, as was being paid to him and the subsequent release of COLA/DA shall be applicable to him as and when the same is released by the concerned Corporation.
 - iii. No arrears on account of pay or COLA/DA shall be paid in favour of the officials.
 - iv. The salary shall be released in favour of the officials from the date he join his duties.
 - v. They shall retain his lien, seniority and promotion prospects at his parent Corporation viz. JK Cements Limited.

vi. The officials shall remain on the rolls of J&K Cements Limited and shall not opt for the Golden Handshake Scheme which shall be certified by the concerned Organization.

vii. The above arrangement shall be reversible without any notice;

viii. The post vacated by the official in J&K Cements Limited shall be deemed to have been frozen and shall not be filled up by promotion or by direct recruitment.

ix. The official so deployed shall furnish an undertaking duly attested by the 1st Class Magistrate stating therein that he/she has no right to claim for permanent absorption in the department/Corporation and will not approach any Hon'ble Court of Law for the said purpose.

x. The Pay level and designation shall not be taken as authentic and shall be subject to further verification by Managing Director JK Cements Limited /J&K Advisory Board for Development of Kisans in his LPCs to be issued
