## **Terms of reference:**

- i. To prepare Union territory specific Maritime and Waterways Transport Master Plan.
- ii. To monitor the implementation of Projects and Schemes as outlined in the Maritime Master Plan.
- iii. To define key performance indicators (KPIs) and benchmarks to measure the success of implementation initiatives and projects.
- iv. To conduct reviews of existing maritime sector policies in the Union territory of J&K to identify gaps and areas for improvement.
- v. To evaluate the outputs and outcomes of maritime initiatives within the Union territory of J&K.
- vi. To promote the adoption of eco-friendly technologies and practice across the sector in the Union territory, including vessel controls, alternative duels and waste management solutions.

- vii. To assess the existing waterway infrastructure and potential for development within the union territory in collaboration with IWAI.
- viii. To develop infrastructure and facilities to support the growth of cruise tourism within the Union territory.
