Terms of References:

- ii. To ensure development and maintenance of a dedicated online portal for real-time monitoring and reporting.

- iii. To ensure convergence across sectors such as sports, education, culture, tourism, industry and skill development for holistic youth engagement.
- iv. To facilitate new initiatives such as cultural festivals, youth summits, skill expos, entrepreneurship melas, etc.
- v. To encourage collaboration with private sector, NGOs, international bodies and community organizations for scalability.
- vi. To periodically review progress of district-level action plans, evaluate outcomes, and suggest corrective measures.

- iv. To involve Panchayati Raj Institutions, NGOs, and local clubs for maximizing outreach and inclusivity.
- v. To submit quarterly progress reports to the Steering Committee with details of outcomes, success stories and operational challenges with suggestions for improvement.
